

# A SPLENDID LITTLE WAR

ERRATA AND CLARIFICATIONS 7-30-2009

## Errata

1. There are 4 Crippled counters that are not use in the game as published.
2. Spanish Command Clarifications:
  - All non-naval Spanish commanders can command any non-naval Spanish unit.
  - Naval leader Bustamante can command any Spanish unit.
  - Other leaders cannot command Naval infantry and artillery.
3. Turn 1 Reinforcements:
  - In practice they cause an overstack, so US T 1 reinforcements should setup within one hex of at start units but may NOT set up closer to Spanish units than at start units. Yeah, this is a bad fix, but the idea is not to overstack them, so back turn 1 reinforcements a hex down the road to Guasimas or so.
4. There are no entrenchments allowed in city hexes.
5. If you run out of Out of Control markers, feel free to make your own. They are not limited by the counter mix.

## Q&A

Q1: Are garrison units in 1708 prohibited from moving until activated?

*NO*

Q2: Can Tercio Guerrillas perform 'Fire and Flight'?

*NO*

Q3: To have captured a hex do you need to be the last to occupy or do you need to occupy at game end?

*LAST TO OCCUPY*

Q4: LOS – what if it follows hex spine between blocking/non-blocking?

*DOES NOT BLOCK*

Q5: Do Command (ie OoC) rules apply to the balloon?

*NO*

Q6: Do ZoCs affect the tracing of command?

*YES. COMMAND CANNOT BE TRACED INTO OR THROUGH AN ENEMY ZOC*

Q7: What happens to leaders who have all units they are with eliminated?

*THE LEADER IS ELIMINATED*

Q8: What happens if a leader is alone in a hex in ZOC of enemy?

*CANNOT TRACE LOS OR LOC. IS ELIMINATED IF ATTACKED. MAY RETREAT IF ENEMY ENTERS HEX IN THE DIRECTION OF NEAREST SUPPLY PATH.*

Q9: Is the gatling gun an artillery unit for stacking purposes?

*YES*

Q10: Does being the target of artillery fire (from > 2 hexes) activate the garrison?

*NO*

Q11: Does Garrison activation ONLY occur during Spanish turn? Or could it activate during defensive fire (for example)?

*EITHER WAY*

Q12: Bustamante is the only leader that can command naval units but can he command other Spanish units?

*YES*

Q13: Can the generic Spanish leaders (e.g. Linares) command Escario's units?

*YES*

Q14: Can OoC units defensive fire?

*Yes*

## **Optional Rule**

If players agree, then forts can be deemed to be constantly in supply. They do not act as a supply source for units in other hexes. This will typically favor the Spanish (though it should also be realized that it will make it more difficult to retake forts captured by the US.
